- Personalise learning to each learner's unique strengths, interests, and passions, fostering joy, motivation, and a lifelong love for learning.


Curriculum Approach at Nadeen

Nadeen Lens - Our Six Guiding Principles

Curriculum Structure and Implementation

Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

- Individualised learning plans are created based on ongoing observations, ensuring that each learner's unique developmental needs are met in a playful, supportive environment.

Key Stages 1 and 2

- Learners in Key Stages 1 and 2 are introduced to core subjects like English, Mathematics, and Science, alongside creative subjects like Art, Music, and Physical Education.
- Cross-curricular projects provide opportunities for learners to explore topics in depth, making learning exciting, relevant, and full of joy.
- We prioritise a strong foundation in literacy and numeracy, while encouraging learners to approach each subject with curiosity, creativity, and confidence.

Key Stage 3

- In Years 7-9, learners continue to explore a rich curriculum, blending core subjects with exciting opportunities for creative expression and independent thought.
- With an emphasis on critical thinking, collaboration, and exploration, we make learning in Key Stage 3 both challenging and joyful.
- Learners have opportunities to engage in cross-disciplinary projects, working together to solve problems and discover new ideas.

Key Stage 4 (iGCSE)

- Years 10-11 focus on preparing learners for iGCSEs, offering a balanced curriculum that encourages both academic rigour and personal growth.
- Regular assessments and personalised support help learners stay on develop, while celebrating the joy of mastering new skills and reaching their goals.
- Our learners are encouraged to explore their interests, set ambitious goals, and celebrate their successes along the way.

Co-Curricular and Enrichment Programs
