Sixth Form facilities

The Post-16 provision fosters a culture of independence, learning and success, and provides a wide range of opportunities for learners to flourish as individuals. Every learner will be supported and encouraged to aim high, enjoy new experiences and achieve their full potential.

Our learner support system is led by an experienced team, including a dedicated Academic Mentor, who works alongside Sixth Form tutors to provide personalised guidance throughout each learner's journey. The Sixth Form team provides support and guidance to learners throughout and beyond their A-Level study, as well as delivering a full PSHE programme geared towards managing the transitions learners experience.

We aim to help all learners adjust to the new working methods of Post-16 study in a caring environment underpinned by a culture of hard work and commitment.

Our full-time Academic Mentor provides one-to-one support to help learners improve their study skills. We develop strong partnerships with all of our learners, ensuring that we provide regular careers guidance, financial advice and specific UCAS application support.

Entry requirements*

In the Sixth Form, subject curriculums are demanding. Learners are challenged to gain a depth of knowledge and skills. This prepares them well for the demands of future learning and careers.

A Levels

All learners must attain five A–C grades at IGCSE/GCSE, including a grade C in English Language and Mathematics.

Entry requirements vary by course and may include specific IGCSE/GCSE grades.

All learners are expected to choose four A Levels in Year 12. However, learners may choose to focus on 3 A Levels for Year 13. All learners will follow the Pearson Edexcel EPQ programme across the two years.

Level 3 BTEC Courses

All learners must attain five A–C grades at IGCSE/GCSE.

Learners without a grade C in English Language and Maths will be required to follow a resit programme alongside their normal studies.

*All entry requirements are subject to the school's final decision and will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
